HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 152, L. D. 190, Bill, "An Act Relating  
to Payment of Expenses of Lewiston Municipal Court."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 17" and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Sec. 17. City to provide courtroom; rental; expenses to be paid by county. Said court shall be held at such place as the city of Lewiston shall provide; ~~and said city shall have power and it shall be its duty to raise money to purchase blanks, blank books, seals, docketts and all things necessary for the use of said court; and to~~ Said city shall provide a suitable room for said court and shall furnish the same in an appropriate manner, for which it shall be paid from the treasury of the county of Androscoggin, as rental, in quarterly payments, the sum of \$3,500 annually. The county of Androscoggin shall purchase blanks, blank-books, seals, docketts and all things necessary for the use of said court.' "
