SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 157, L. D. 204, Resolve, Proposing an
Amendment to the Constitution Changing the Tenure of
Office of the Governor to Four-Year Terms.

Amend said Resolve in that part designated "Section 14" by
indicating the striking out of the word "exercise" in the 3rd line
by drawing a line through said word, as follows '~~exercise~~', and by
inserting immediately after said stricken out word, the underlined
word 'assume'

Further amend said Resolve in that part designated "Section 14"
by adding after the underlined words "date of" in the 12th line, the
underlined punctuation and words ', or after,' ; and by adding after
the underlined words "case the" in the 12th line, the underlined
word 'then'
