COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 159, L.D. 206, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Bounty on Bears."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the colon at the end of the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"For a period of 2 years, from August 13, ~~1955~~ 1957, ~~except-in-that~~
~~portion-of-Franklin-county-north-of-the-Appalachian-Trail~~ in Pisca-
taquis county only, a bounty of \$15 shall be paid for each and every
bear killed in organized townships and plantations and unorganized
townships adjoining organized townships and plantations to the
person killing the same, by the treasurer of the organized township
or plantation in which said bear was killed or the treasurer of any
organized township or plantation adjoining the unorganized territory
in which said bear was killed."
