STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 122, amended. The first sentence of section 122 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'For a period of 2 years, from August 13, 1955 1957, except in that portion of Franklin county north of the Appalachian Trail, a bounty of \$15 shall be paid for each and every bear killed in organized townships and plantations and unorganized townships adjoining organized townships and plantations to the person killing the same, by the treasurer of the organized township or plantation in which said bear was killed or the treasurer of any organized township or plantation adjoining the unorganized territory in which said bear was killed.'
