RESOLVE, Regulating Black Bass Fishing in Sebec Lake, Piscataquis County.

Sebec lake; regulating black bass fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation providing that there shall be no bag limit or size limit on black bass taken in Sebec lake, county of Piscataquis.
