AN ACT Relating to Part-Time Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 31, amended. The 7th paragraph from the end of section 31 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The Commission may grant part-time licenses for a period not in excess of 6 consecutive months ~~from May 1st to October 31st~~ in any fiscal year. ~~The person so licensed shall not conduct any business on the licensed premises during the months from November to April, both inclusive.~~'
