STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Regina M. Babine of Bath.

Regina M. Babine; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Regina M. Babine, of Bath, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Babine is 27 years of age and has Multiple Sclerosis and has been confined to a wheelchair for 4 years. She has no use of her hands for any type of work and is supported by her parents. Her father is a retired railroad employee and has as his only income a small pension.
