STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Lobster Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 117-A, additional. Chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 117-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 117-A. Lifting lobsters pots. No person shall raise, lift or transfer any pot, trap or other contrivance that is set for the taking of lobsters from $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after sunset until $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise of the following morning. For the purpose of this section, the time shall be that which is recognized as legal in the State of Maine.'
