IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, To Study Advisability of State Office Building in Bangor.

State office building in Bangor; study advisability. Resolved: That the Bureau of Public Improvements of the Department of Finance and Administration be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a State office building in Bangor for the purpose of determining whether state governmental activities would be materially improved as a result of relocation and centralization of certain departmental functions personally conducted in that area: and be it further

Resolved: That the Bureau shall report the result of its study to the next Legislature.
