STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Selectmen of Town of Mount Desert.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1929, c. 97, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 97 of the private and special laws of 1929 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 6. Compensation. Each selectman shall receive for his services the sum of two hundred dollars \$400 in full for his services in whatever capacity rendered, together with his actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties, to be paid monthly by the town treasurer on the first day of every month during his term of office.'
