STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicles Emerging from Alley, Driveway or Building.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 131-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 131-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 131-A. Emerging from alley, driveway or building. The driver of a vehicle within a business or residential district emerging from an alley, driveway or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto a sidewalk or onto the sidewalk area extending across any alleyway, and shall yield the right of way to any pedestrian as may be necessary to avoid collision, and upon entering the roadway shall yield the right of way to all vehicles approaching on said roadway.'
