IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Limitations on Overtaking Motor Vehicles on the Left.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 117, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 117 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and pass or attempt to overtake and pass another vehicle proceeding in the same direction upon a grade or upon a curve in the way, where the driver's view along the way is obstructed within a distance of ~~400~~ 600 feet.'
