COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 95, L. D. 225, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to Provide for Election of Members of the Executive Council.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the question "Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature to provide for election of members of the Executive Council?" and inserting in place thereof "Shall Section 2 of Part Second of Article V of the Constitution, which now provides that the Councillors shall be chosen biennally, on the first Wednesday of January, by joint ballot of the Senators and Representatives in convention, be amended so as to provide that each Councillor shall be elected by the qualified electors of the county of the district entitled to such councillor and shall hold office for two years from the first Wednesday of January next succeeding his election?"

Reported by the Committee on Constitutional Amendments (Report A) Read and adopted in the Senate May 8, 1957.
