IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Umbagog Lake, Oxford County.

Umbagog lake; regulating fishing. Resolved. That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Umbagog lake in Magalloway Plt. and in Upton, Oxford county, to ice fishing for pickerel, hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs, white fish and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st.
