AN ACT Increasing Debt Limit Under Small Claims Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 109, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 109 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Sec. 1. “Small claim” defined. A “small claim” is any right of action cognizable by a court of law not involving the title to real estate in which the debt or damage claimed does not exceed ~~\$35~~ \$50.’
