## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Purposes and Powers of Continental Mills and to Authorize it to Acquire the Assets of Continental Mills Co.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Continental Mills to acquire certain assets. Continental Mills, a corporation organized and existing under Chapter 448 of the Private and Special Laws of 1865, as amended by Chapter 60 of the Private and Special Laws of 1875 and by Chapter 34 of the Private and Special Laws of 1951, is hereby authorized to acquire by any appropriate means all the assets of whatever nature of Continental Mills Co., a corporation organized under the general laws of this State and a wholly-owned subsidiary of Continental Mills, and thereafter to have and exercise, in addition to the powers and purposes theretofore held and exercised by it, all the powers and purposes of Continental Mills Co. as set out in its certificate of organization filed in the office of the Secretary of State of Maine on December 18, 1956.
