AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Judge of the Kennebunk Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1923, c. 15, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1923, as amended by chapter 101 of the private and special laws of 1945 and by chapter 29 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘**Sec. 15. Salaries of judge and recorder.** The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of ~~\$1,600~~ \$2,000 per annum to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of \$600 per annum, payable quarterly.’

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1957.
