RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Ragged Pond, Piscataquis County.

Ragged pond; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 fish and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait in Ragged pond, T9, R10, Piscataquis county.
