AN ACT Relating to Taking Marine Worms in Woolwich, Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 125-A, amended. Section 125-A of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, as follows:

'The provisions of this section shall not apply to the town of Woolwich, Sagadahoc county.'
