IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing a Mobile Unit for Registering Voters in Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 3, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 218 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by inserting after the 4th sentence, a new sentence, to read as follows: 'The Chairman of the Board of Registration of every city or any members thereof may, if it is deemed advisable, operate or cause to be operated a mobile registration unit for the purpose of registering voters in such city as set forth in the Revised Statutes; said mobile registration units to be used at such times and places as the Chairman of the Board of Registration or respective members thereof shall deem advisable.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 3, § 43-A, additional. Chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 43-A, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 43-A. Mobile registration unit. The municipal officers of a town may, if they deem it advisable, operate or cause to be operated a mobile registration unit for the purpose of registering voters in such town as set forth in the Revised Statutes; said mobile registration units to be used at such times and places as the municipal officers shall deem advisable.'
