STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Funeral Expenses in Aid to the Blind and Aid to the Disabled.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 25, § 315, amended. Section 315 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 315. Funeral expenses of persons aided. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$125 \$150 shall be paid by the State if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 25, § 319-N, amended. Section 319-N of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 30 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 319-N. Funeral expenses of person assisted. On the death of a recipient, reasonable funeral expenses not exceeding \$125 \$150 shall be paid by the State, if the estate of the deceased is insufficient to pay the same.'
