STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Military Leave Credits Under Maine State Police Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15, § 22-A, additional. Chapter 15 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 22-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 22-A. Military leave credits. No credits toward retirement under the provisions of section 22 shall be allowed to any member of the State Police in military service beyond the period of first enlistment or induction into the armed forces of the United States unless the individual involved is compelled to continue service under some mandatory provision of the Selective Service Act.'
