IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Waldoboro for Aid Extended to Leverett Carter.

Town of Waldoboro; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$609.08 to be paid to the town of Waldoboro to reimburse it for aid given to Leverett Carter.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Marie Carter and her son Leverett Carter moved to Waldoboro sometime in the latter part of 1952.

Mrs. Carter applied for aid, and a pauper's notice was sent to Swan's Island, the town of settlement. This pauper's notice through error did not include the name of the son, Leverett. Leverett is non compos mentis. Subsequently, Swan's Island paid the town of Waldoboro the sum of \$432.95 for aid to the mother leaving a balance of \$609.08 still owing to Waldoboro for aid to the son. Due to the inadvertence or lack of knowledge of the Overseers of Poor of the town of Waldoboro, the sum of \$609.08 was expended for the son, and for which the town of Waldoboro has not been reimbursed.
