STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Judge and Recorder of Piscataquis Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 166, § 21, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 21 of chapter 166 of the private and special laws of 1911, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 121 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive a salary of \$7,700 \$2,200 per year, to be taxed as a part of the costs to be paid him in quarterly payments from the county treasury of Piscataquis county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 166, § 5, amended. The last sentence of section 5 of chapter 166 of the private and special laws of 1911, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 121 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby futher amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall be paid for all services as recorder of said Piscataquis municipal court an annual salary of \$600 \$800 in quarterly payments on the 1st days of January, April, July and October of each year from the county treasury of Piscataquis county.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1957.
