STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Persons Operating Farm Tractors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No registration or license shall be required for a farm tractor when the same is used solely for farming purposes, and such farm tractors may be operated, without registration or license, from or to the premises where the same are kept, to or from a farm lot and between farm lots, used for farm purposes by the owner of the farm tractor; and such. Such farm tractors may be operated, without registration or license, from or to a filling station or garage for gas, oil or repairs; provided that when such farm tractors are operated on the highways in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph, they shall not be operated by any person who at the time was not eligible to obtain a Maine operator's license.'
