

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Hours for Public Dance Halls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 134, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph, at the end thereof, to read as follows:

'In determining when the Lord's Day begins and ends under the provisions of this section as it applies to public dance halls, the hours shall be United States Eastern Standard Time.'
