RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Katharine M. Rolfe of Bridgton.

Teacher's pension granted to Katharine M. Rolfe. Resolved: That Katharine M. Rolfe, of Bridgton, be given credit for an additional 2 year teaching service so that she may be entitled to a retirement benefit under the provisions of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Katharine M. Rolfe taught at Bridgton Academy from 1917 to 1919. She has 1834 years of credit under the Maine Retirement System. Did not receive credit for Bridgton Academy where she taught and was preceptress. Also taught in New Hampshire.
