RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Robert McFarland of Bradford.

Robert McFarland; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$30 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Robert McFarland, of Bradford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. McFarland is 61 years of age and unable to work due to multiple injuries sustained in an automobile accident occurring on December 6, 1953 in which several ribs were broken, both legs fractured and his back severely injured. His wife receives \$49 per month in Old Age Assistance. They have no children. The town of Bradford contributes to their support.
