AN ACT Relating to the Measuring of Herring.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 24, amended. The second sentence of the second paragraph of section 24 of chapter 38, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The measure shall be in 5 hogshead divisions, measured by liquid measure with a metered pump as it is pumped in, cut $\frac{3}{8}$ of an inch deep in the hold of the boat and measured while boat is afloat. Said marking shall be made on the forward and aft end in each hold on the permanent part of the bulk head, to extend to the top of the hatch coaming.'
