IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Exempting Persons Sixty Years of Age from Poll Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ IV, ¶ D, amended. Paragraph D of subsection IV of section 10 of chapter 91-A, as enacted by section one of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘D. The polls of all persons who have attained the age of ~~70~~ 60 years and the polls and estates of all persons who by reason of infirmity or poverty are in the judgment of the assessors unable to contribute toward the public charges.’
