RESOLVE, in Favor of Animal-Poultry Science Building at University of Maine.

Animal-Poultry Science Building; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of \$644,100 in favor of the University of Maine to construct and equip an animal-poultry science building (animal pathology building addition); and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This project would provide an addition to the Animal Pathology Building built in 1950 from funds appropriated by the Legislature in 1949. The facilities which would be provided in the addition are urgently needed for instruction and research in animal and poultry sciences, bacteriology, and biochemistry. Without this addition the University could not adequately meet the increasing demands for essential services (diagnosis, testing, disease control) from the poultry and livestock industries of the State.
