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

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fortnightly Payment of Salaries and Wages to State Officers and Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 29, amended. The third paragraph of section 29 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All state officers and regular employees except temporary and seasonal employees shall be paid their salaries or wages weekly fortnightly, the dates of payment to be determined by the State Controller: provided, however, that payment Payment may be made once in each calendar month or fortnightly to such state officers and employees as consent to such time of payment. Temporary and seasonal employees of the State shall be paid at such time as the Commissioner of Finance and Administration shall specify.'
