AN ACT Relating to Fees for Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 116, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 8. Fees. Grand and traverse jurors attending the Superior Court and jurors attending on any other occasion prescribed by law shall be allowed \$10 ~~for each day's actual~~ **a day for their** attendance, and 10c a mile for their travel out and home once each week, to be paid out of the county treasury.'
