AN ACT Relating to Pollution Survey.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 7-A, additional. Chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 7-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Pollution surveys. The Commission is authorized to pay up to 50%, or \$2,500, whichever is less, of the expenses of a sewage survey for a municipal or quasi-municipal corporation which shall have been approved as to purpose, necessity and priority. Municipalities and quasi-municipal corporations are specifically authorized to make such contracts with the State as are deemed necessary and may pay over moneys to the State to carry out the foregoing purposes.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958, any unexpended balance not to lapse but to be carried forward for the same purposes to the next fiscal year; and the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959. All unexpended balances on June 30, 1959 shall lapse.
