## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Pollution Abatement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 7-B, additional. Chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 7-B, to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 7-B. State contribution to pollution abatement. The Commission is authorized to pay up to 20% of the total cost, or two-thirds of the total federal contribution under P. L. 660, 84th Congress, whichever is less, to the expense of a municipal or quasi-municipal pollution abatement construction program which has received federal approval and federal funds for construction.'
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$418,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958, any unexpended balance not to lapse but to be carried forward for the same purposes to the next fiscal year; and the sum of \$418,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959. All unexpended balances on June 30, 1959 shall lapse.
