AN ACT Increasing Pensions of Elderly Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ II, ¶ C, sub-¶¶ 1, 2 and 3, amended. Subparagraphs 1, 2 and 3 of paragraph C of subsection II of section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section one of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955, and as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

1. ~~\$7,000~~ **\$1,300**, if the member has at least 35 years of creditable service as a teacher;
2. ~~\$900~~ **\$1,200**, if the member has at least 30 but less than 35 years of creditable service as a teacher; or
3. ~~\$800~~ **\$1,100**, if the member has at least 25 but less than 30 years of creditable service as a teacher.'
