## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### **RESOLVE**, Creating the Maine Practical Nurse Training Scholarship Fund.

Trust fund for Maine Practical Nurse Training Centers; created. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, transferred from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$2,000, for each year of the biennium ending June 30, 1959, such sum to be established and known as the "Scholarship Fund for Maine Practical Nurse Training"; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the State Board of Education be authorized to develop and administer a plan for awarding scholarships to students enrolled at the Practical Nurse Training Centers whose records provide evidence of the possession of such qualifications as are necessary to successfully complete the course and become competent in their profession, but who although they have demonstrated their ability and willingness to support the expenses of their training, may be in need of some financial assistance with respect to such expenses. No scholarship shall exceed \$200 in any one year. The Board may, at its discretion, rely on the recommendation of the Principal of each school and the Director of Practical Nurse Training, as to the amount of any particular award to an eligible recipient. Amounts available for such scholarships shall be allocated annually to the use of the Maine Practical Nurse Training Centers on the basis of evidence of individual need of worthy students.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Practical Nurse Training is vitally important and necessary for the welfare of the people of the State of Maine. A scholarship fund is requested to aid worthy students to receive the necessary training.
