STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Taking Herring Under Four Inches in Length.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 24-A, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 24-A of chapter 38 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The tolerance of 25% herein set out shall be determined by numerical count weight or volume of $\frac{1}{2}$ bushel of herring for each 500 bushels of herring or fraction thereof, taken at random from various parts of said lot.'
