STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase Salaries of Judge and Recorder of Van Buren Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 18, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1" of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by chapter 103 of the private and special laws of 1953, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be $\frac{2}{2,400}$ \$3,000 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 18, amended. The 3rd sentence of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 1" of chapter 54 of the private and special laws of 1947, which amended chapter 18 of the private and special laws of 1939, as last amended by chapter 136 of the private and special laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'His salary shall be \$700 \$1,100 a year, to be paid monthly from the treasury of the county of Aroostook.'
