## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

#### RESOLVE, in Favor Willis L. Cushing of Portland, Maine.

Willis L. Cushing; World War I bonus. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100 to be paid to Willis L. Cushing of Portland, Maine, as the World War I bonus authorized under the provisions of chapter 294 of the public laws of 1919, said sum to be paid from the general fund of the State.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Every honorably discharged veteran of World War I was voted a state bonus of \$100 if application was made by a certain date. Mr. Cushing is a veteran of World War I and receives a World War I service pension. Because of administration error, Mr. Cushing's name was not listed as a veteran at the time the bonus was paid and has never received such payment.
