STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Procuring Testimonials for the Purpose of Marking the Unmarked Graves of the Soldiers of the Revolutionary War.

Marking of graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War; appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$200 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958, for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War; and be it further

Resolved: That with the approval of the Governor and Council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the "Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution," with which they are hereby authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There are numerable unmarked graves of soldiers of the Revolutionary War. It would seem fitting that these graves should be marked.
