AN ACT Relating to Speed of Commercial Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 107, amended. Section 107 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 107. Commercial vehicles; speed.** ~~No~~ Unless otherwise posted, no commercial vehicle equipped with pneumatic tires and registered for a gross weight of over 6,000 pounds shall be operated on open country ways at a rate of speed exceeding ~~40~~ 50 miles per hour, or within the compact, built up portions of any city, town or village at a rate of speed exceeding ~~20~~ 30 miles per hour, said ways and built up portions being defined in section 113; nor shall any commercial vehicle equipped with 2 or more solid tires be operated on said open country ways at a rate of speed exceeding 25 miles per hour or within said compact, built up portions at a rate of speed exceeding 15 miles per hour.'
