**RESOLVE, Authorizing Henry L. Barker to Pay Certain Monies to Credit of Penobscot Indian Fund.**

---

**Henry L. Barker; to pay certain monies. Resolved:** That Henry L. Barker turn over to the Treasurer of the State for the Penobscot Indian Fund the sum of \$420.61 being held by him.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Several years ago Henry L. Barker bought stumpage on Orson Island from certain Indians. After it was cut, it was found that the Indians selling the stumpage did not own all of it. A survey was made and it was found that some \$662.99 was due to owners unknown. Certain Indians have proven their claims and collected their share.

Mr. Barker now has \$420.61 of unclaimed money belonging to unknown Indians. It is felt that this money should go into the Indian Fund as there have been no claimants after nearly five years.
