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**AN ACT to Amend the Amount of Supplement Loans by Maine School  
Building Authority.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1955, c. 474, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of chapter 474 of the public laws of 1955 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the State the sum of ~~\$100,000~~ \$50,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956 for carrying out the purposes of this act. This appropriation shall be a continuing account and any balances remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year.'
