RESOLVE, Providing Disability Retirement Pension Increase for Edward E. Jones of Chelsea.

Edward E. Jones; retirement pension increased. Resolved: That the disability retirement pension now being paid to Edward Jones, of Chelsea, under the provisions of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, be increased from \$100 per month to \$150 per month.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Jones retired on disability and is getting about \$100 per month. He has a bad heart. Mr. Jones worked for the State Highway Department.
