STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Trapping Season for Muskrats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 113- sub-§ I, amended. The 4th paragraph of subsection I of section 113 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The open season on mink and muskrat shall be during the month of November in each calendar year; except that the open season on muskrat in Washington and York counties county shall be only from March 20th to April 20th, inclusive in each year.'
