**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Bemis Stream, Franklin County.**

---

**Bemis stream; regulating fishing. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bemis stream in Rangeley Plt., Franklin county, from the north side of the railroad bridge at summit to the red posts at the mouth of the stream on Mooselookmeguntic lake to fly fishing only from April 1 to September 15 with a daily limit of 5 fish.
