RESOLVE, Designating New Bridge to Span Jonesport Reach from the Town of Jonesport to the Town of Beals as "Beals Bridge."

"Beals Bridge;" designated. **Resolved:** That the new bridge being constructed across Jonesport Reach from the town of Jonesport to the town of Beals, in the county of Washington, under the provisions of chapter 198 of the private and special laws of 1955, be officially named and referred to as "Beals Bridge."
