**RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Evonne J. Rollins of
West Gardiner.**

Evonne J. Rollins; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Evonne J. Rollins, of West Gardiner, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July, 1957 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Evonne J. Rollins is 27 years of age and has tuberculosis. She was at the Fairfield Sanatorium from July 1956 to January 1957. She is unable to work.
