**AN ACT Relating to License Plates for Motor Vehicle Owners Who are
Sheriffs and Deputy Sheriffs.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 47-D, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 47-D, to read as follows:

'Special License Plates for Sheriffs.

Sec. 47-D. Special license plates to motor vehicle owners who are sheriffs and deputy sheriffs. Owners of motor vehicles who are residents of this State and who are sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, upon application, complying with the State Motor Vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles and upon the payment of an additional fee of \$2, shall be issued license plates for private passenger cars of a color and shape to be selected by the Secretary of State. The license plate shall contain at the top the words "Sheriff Department" and at the bottom the name of the county and the word "Maine." The sheriff of each county shall have number one and the chief deputy number 2 and the other deputies to have numbers as numerically assigned by the sheriff.'
